

## Supervision of Key Worker's/Vulnerable Children

### **Where:**

Assembly Hall

Please bring your child/ren to the main front door at 9am. A member of staff will be there. Children will also be collected at the main front door. Each child will only be in for their normal school time, that is, 9.00 – 11am/2pm/3pm.

### **PPE:**

Sanitiser, gloves, tissues and aprons are available in the Assembly Hall. All will be used according to our regularly reviewed Covid risk assessments.

### **Safeguarding & Child Protection:**

All normal safeguarding practices apply. One of SMPS Safeguarding team will always be onsite during supervision.

### **Relevant Information:**

Children bring their own snack and lunch.

Uniform is optional.

From Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> January, children bring their own work packs and pencils/crayons/markers that they might normally use at home. They will have a space to complete their class teacher activities – Seesaw and/or work pack, in school but there will not be 1 to 1 teaching support. They may bring a device from home and play any offline activities already saved onto it. These devices will be unable to connect to school internet.

Supervisors and children may use the outdoor area of the school if the weather is suitable. Regular ventilation will be a priority so it is important your children come with warm clothing, coats etc.

School cleaning will happen as normal regardless of lockdown.
